"You have to trust the process. Change is not going to happen overnight."

Daelyn Bagwell was tested for autism at just 18 months old. After trying other services for two years, his family brought him to Autism ETC. Daelyn started receiving ABA services on a part-time basis, and is now attending the Day Therapy Program full-time. Daelyn is still non-verbal, but he is learning to use the PECS system so that he can communicate with others," said Samantha. "He is finally able to communicate his wants and needs. He is able to work puzzles and play with building blocks. He is now able to sit and perform tasks rather than becoming frustrated. As a parent, I have learned to celebrate the small victories. I am learning to see the positives, and not compare his progress to anyone else."
