Zealand was diagnosed with autism at 18 months old, but was successfully attending school with minimal issues until 2021, when he got COVID, and later strep throat. These illnesses changed his personality, causing him to become aggressive toward others. Since coming to AETC, Zealand has made tremendous progress, and has been able to integrate better into family life. Zealand has improved so much, he and his family are now able to attend church.

"Church is an important part of our lives but with Zealand's behavioral issues, it made it difficult to attend church," said mom, Nancy. "Now we are able to go for short periods of time which is an improvement. Zealand has improved and I have learned what are his triggers and I have the guidance I need to handle situations so that everyone is safe."

Nancy's advice to parents is, "Trust the individuals who are caring for your child at Autism ETC. They have nothing but the best intentions for your child. You don't need to worry. Your child will make progress."

Letter: Vv Shape: Pentagon Color: Brown

Preschool: Anticipate next steps in familiar games and routines

School age: Retell stories, compose larger shapes from smaller shapes, going to front of classroom, rocks

Week 2: Community Helpers Week 1

Letter: Ww Shape: Octagon Color: Black

Preschool: Body part awareness

School age: Writing letters for letter sounds, position of shapes, raising hand to answer questions, trash and recycling

Week 3: Community Helpers Week 2

Letter: Xx Shape: Hexagon Color: Gray Preschool: Responding to familiar requests

School age: Isolating/pronouncing CVC words, classifying/counting/comparing, using classroom materials as designed, rocks

Week 4: Construction

Letter: Yy Shape: Trapezoid Color: Silver Preschool: Follow one-step directions

School age: Relationships between illustrations and text, patterns, obtaining materials for tasks when told what's needed, building

Week 5: Pets

Letter: Zz Shape: Star Color: Gold Preschool: Listening to simple stories

School age: Identifying main topic, understanding number lines, returning materials to correct location, fish


