Spotlight Story

This month, our spotlight story is about Carson Connell, who's been receiving services at our Glendale, Arizona clinic since March 2023.

His mom, Katrina, says he was developing normally as a baby, but started regressing when he was two. Carson was eventually diagnosed with autism, and started ABA and speech therapy while the family lived in California.

"I was leaving the military and my fiancé and I were planning to move to Arizona, so I began to search for ABA service providers as I wanted to be prepared for the transition. I called a few ABA providers, but when I called Autism ETC, I felt like this was what Carson needed."



Carson started on a part-time basis while also attending preschool, but Katrina felt like that was hindering his progress, so he started coming to Autism ETC full-time.

"Over the course of the last year, I have seen a drastic change in Carson. At first we were using visuals and considered using an AAC device to help him with communicating. Now he is able to talk in complete sentences. He can advocate for himself. He is flying through his goals and he comes home and tells me about his day. He is as

happy each day as he is excited to see his friends and the staff that works with him," said Katrina.

Letter: Ff Shape: Diamond Color: Purple Preschool: Answering basic questions about books School age: Isolating/pronouncing CVC words, counting to 20 using multiple arrays, imitating group activities, all about plants

Week 3: Transportation

Letter: Gg Shape: Heart Color: Pink Preschool: Using body movements to communicate School age: Long/short vowels, greater than/lesser than/equal to, verbally responding to large group instructions, simple machines
