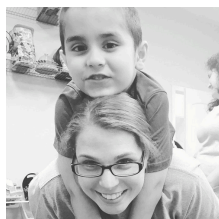




## **SPOTLIGHT STORY**

Letter: Ii Shape: Pentagon Color: Brown  
Preschool: Exploring books and turning pages

School age: Identify settings in a text, measurement using weight, verbally responding to large group instructions, insects

#### Week 2: Colors

Letter: Jj Shape: Octagon Color: Black  
Preschool: Physical properties of a book  
School age: Identifying events in a text, comparing measurement attributes, responding to directions, birds and chicks

#### Week 3: Earth and Environment

Letter: Kk Shape: Hexagon Color: Grey  
Preschool: Associations between books on the same topic  
School age: Opposites and using them to understand word meanings, subtraction within 5, independent work, and all about earth for science

#### Week 4: Dr. Seuss

Letter: Ll Shape: Trapezoid Color: Silver  
Preschool: Performing actions from a book  
School age: Rhyming words, subtraction within 10, responding to greetings, weather
