Week 1: Ocean

Letter: Rr Shape: Triangle Color: Blue Preschool: Write name on paper

School age: Using prepositions, identifying 3D shapes, imitating group activities, shells

Week 2: Ocean

Letter: Ss Shape: Diamond Color: Purple Preschool: Make lines and shapes with variety of tools to represent objects School age: Answering questions about texts with key details, identifying shapes in the environment, verbally responding in large group instructions, shells

Week 3: Outer Space

Letter: Tt Shape: Heart Color: Pink Preschool: Participating in songs/rhymes School age: Compare/contrast experience of characters in different texts, similarities and differences in shapes, responding to teacher directions, space/sun/moon

Week 4: Outer Space

Letter: Uu Shape: Crescent Color: White Preschool: Word play/finger games School age: Expressing opinions of a text, modeling shapes in the world by drawing, independent work, space/sun/moon

Week 5: Summer

Letter: Vv Shape: Pentagon Color: Brown Preschool: Anticipating next steps in familiar games/routines

School age: Retelling stories, composing larger shapes from smaller ones, coming to front of class, colors
