“Adjusting takes time, but the results can be life-changing.”

At just a year old, Julian’s mom noticed he wasn’t speaking and that his motor skills were delayed compared to other kids. She talked with his pediatrician, who recommended an autism evaluation. At two years old, Julian was diagnosed with autism.

His mom immediately signed him up at Autism ETC. She says that at first, Julian had difficulty adjusting, but with the right support, things have changed.

“His behavioral issues have drastically improved—from 96 incidents an hour to just 4,” she said.

Week 1: Summer

Letter: Vv Shape: Pentagon Color: Brown

Preschool: Anticipating next steps, familiar in games/routines

School age: Retelling stories, composing larger shapes from smaller shapes, coming to the front of the class, colors

Week 2: Community Helpers

Letter: Ww Shape: Octagon Color: Black

Preschool: Body part awareness

School age: Write letters for letter sounds, position of shapes, raising hand to answer questions, trash, and recycling

Week 3: Community Helpers

Letter: Xx Shape: Hexagon Color: Grey

Preschool: Following one-step directions

School age: Isolate/pronounce CVC words, classify/count/compare, using classroom materials as designed, rocks

Week 4: Construction

Letter: Yy Shape: Trapezoid Color: Silver

Preschool: Responding to familiar requests

School age: Relations between illustration and texts, patterns, obtaining necessary materials for the task when told what materials are needed, buildings

Week 5: Pets

Letter: Zz Shape: Star Color: Gold

Preschool: Listening to simple stories

School age: Identify a main topic, understanding number lines, returning materials to correct locations, fish
