"She can say a lot of words. She can answer questions. She has learned to read books and she is doing better with her writing skills."

Serenity Randle was around 18 months when her mom noticed she wasn't reaching her developmental milestones. That prompted her to get Serenity tested, and she was eventually diagnosed on the autism spectrum.

Serenity was 3 years old when she started at our Harnett Ct. clinic. "At that time, she had a few behavioral issues. She would not play with other kids. She would stay in her own bubble, and she continued to have some speech delays," said her mom.

Serenity has made extensive progress and will attend school this upcoming school year.

"The staff has helped her get ready for school as she learned about classroom structure and I believe that will help her be successful in the future."

### **Week 1: Dinosaurs**

**Letter:** Aa **Shape:** Circle **Color:** Red

**Preschool:** Learning one step directions

**School age:** Learning to narrate a single event, relationships between numbers and quantity, colors, waiting our turn to complete an activity

### **Week 2: Love/Friendship/Family**

**Letter:** Bb **Shape:** Rectangle **Color:** Orange

**Preschool:** Listen to simple stories

**School age:** Adding details to strengthen writing, one-to-one correspondence, all about my body and teeth, completing tasks, bringing items to the teacher and putting them away

### **Week 3: My Body and Bones**
